SUMMARY:

Under general supervision, prepares drawings and support documents for fabrication of direct fired heaters, waste heat recovery units and air preheat systems.

- Compiles shipping lists and prepares shipping profile sketches in preparation for transporting the manufactured equipment to the client's destination.
