Job Description

Position Objective

Set up and operate powered machinery to bend, form, notch, punch, straighten or stretch metals and structural shapes as specified by blueprints, drawings, layouts or work orders.

Essential Functions

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Sets stops on machine bed, changes dies and adjusts components, such as ram or power press, when making multiple or successive passes.
- Operates power press, power brake, foot-powered press, hydraulic press, batwing, or like machinery to bend, form, notch, stretch, punch or straighten metals.
- Selects and positions flat, block, radius, or special purposes die sets into ram and bed of machine, using hoist, crane, measuring instruments, and hand tools.
- Installs, aligns, and secures gears, holing fixtures, dies to machine bed, using gauges, and/or templates, and hand tools.
- Measures work piece and verifies dimensions and weight, using micrometer, template, straightedge, and scale.
- Completes small part assembly.

Key Competencies

- Two or more years of experience as a machine operator, or related experience.

- Strong written and verbal communication skills

- Deburr and inspect parts.
- Consistently produce quality to specifications and quality standards.

Supervisory Responsibility

This position has no supervisory responsibilities.

Work Environment

This job operates primarily in the shop environment. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is occasionally exposed to fumes or airborne particles, moving mechanical parts and vibration. The noise level in the work environment and manufacturing sites can be loud. Requires wearing appropriate PPE in certain areas of the workplace.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; use hands to handle or feel; and reach with hands and arms. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 40 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.
